Recreational Program – Survey Results

- Results are in "OneDrive\Recreational Program\2021\Survey Results"
- Total responses: 30 players/parents, 15 coaches
 - Grades K-1: 5 + 4 = 9
 - Grades 2-3 (boys): 7 + 1 = 8
 - Grades 2-3 (girls): 1 + 4 = 5
 - Grades 4-5 (boys): 11 + 2 = 13
 - Grade 4-6 (girls): 3 + 2 = 5
 - Grade 6-8 (boys): 3 + 2 = 5
- Response Highlights
 - Players had fun
 - Player's basketball knowledge and/or skills improved
 - Players liked the game structure
 - Player likely to play next year: yes=16, no=7, maybe=7
 - Recommend RLYBL to others: yes=13, no=8, maybe=8
 - Participate in Summer league: yes=13, no=4, maybe=13

Recreational Program – Survey Results

- Teams need to be more balanced
- Announce All-Star games at beginning of season and establish criteria
- Have more players on team for substitution purposes
- Teach fundamentals at practice
- Have officials explain violations
- Require volunteer "buy-out"
- Record wins/losses for NCAA on don't have a tournament
- Play 1st round games of WNCAA tournament at the same time
- Don't allow travel players in recreational program
- Make sure schools are open for practice
- Disappointed with parents yelling at officials and kids
