



## Connor William Prye Memorial Scholarship Application

This scholarship is in memory of Connor William Prye (2003-2020) who was a member of the West Shore Community and Red Land Class of 2023. Connor was a distinguished member of society that understood the importance of friendship, leadership, and service to others. The scholarship has a maximum benefit of two \$1000.00 checks or one \$2000.00 check to be awarded to outstanding Red Land High School senior athletes for use in continuing their education. Funding for the scholarship is made available from donations received by Red Land Youth Basketball (RLYB) and a personal contribution by the Prye family.

To be **eligible** for this scholarship, applicants must meet the following **requirements**:

- Be a graduating senior on a Red Land High School athletic team
- Achieve a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Achieve a cumulative weighted average of 80% or higher
- Have a school record absent of academic infractions (detention, expulsions, etc.) or submit an explanation of infractions approved by school guidance counselor

A committee selected by RLYB will evaluate applications based on the following:

- Leadership in and around the West Shore community
- Personal character
- Recommendation from the applicant's Red Land High School coach

Applicants must **submit** the following to Mr. Aaron Walter in the guidance office no later May 1. 2023 be considered:

- Completed scholarship application
- Explanation of infractions (if necessary)
- Personal essay
- Letter of Recommendation from a Red Land High School coach
